

LICENSING OF LOTTERIES
Rural Municipality of Victoria
By-Law No: 1128/93

BEING A BY-LAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF VICTORIA TO REGULATE THE LICENSING OF
LOTTERIES WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY.

WHEREAS pursuant to Order-in-Council No. 27/84, The Lieutenant-Governor-in-Council has authorized any Municipality, to license any charitable organization located within its boundaries, conduct and manage a Raffle Lottery or a lottery scheme held at a bazaar, as provided in clause (c) of subsection (i) of Section 190 of the Criminal Code of Canada, where the total prizes for each Raffle Lottery does not exceed Three Thousand (\$3,000) Dollars, and each lottery scheme to be held at a bazaar is in accordance with sub-clause (ii) of clause (c).

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED as a By-Law of the Rural Municipality of Victoria, as follows:

1. THAT any charitable organization located within the boundaries of the Municipality of Victoria, may be granted a license to conduct and manage a Raffle Lottery or a lottery scheme held at a bazaar, as provided in clause (c) of subsection (i) of section 190 of the Criminal Code of Canada, where the total prizes for each such Raffle Lottery does not exceed Three Thousand (\$3,000) Dollars, and each lottery scheme to be held at a bazaar is in accordance with sub-clause (ii) of clause (c).

2. THAT an application for licenses as above described shall be in accordance with or shall be in the form attached hereto as Schedules "A" to this By-Law.

3. THAT the financial report of the licensee shall be in form attached hereto as Schedule "B".

4. THAT the fees for the issuing of licenses shall be:

a) Raffle Lotteries:

A license fee of 1% of the total value of Prizes to be awarded.
(Minimum charge \$10.00)

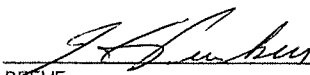
b) Bazaars:

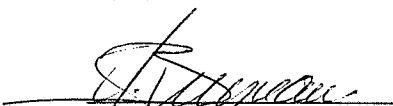
A license fee of \$10.00

6. THAT the Reeve and the Secretary-Treasurer be and they are hereby authorized to do all things necessary to give force and effect to this by-law.
