

## Rural Municipality of Victoria Dog & Cat Pet Owner Notice

Please take Notice that By-Law No: 1329/2010 provides rules and regulations regarding the control of pets within the communities of Holland and Cypress River.

Pet owners are required to produce a certificate from a veterinarian to verify that your pet has been spayed or neutered. Also required is a current Vaccine Certificate ensuring that the pets in your control are free of infectious, contagious or communicable diseases. We ask that you bring along your certificates to ensure your pet has been properly vaccinated and that we charging the correct fee for your pet license.

The current fee for a spayed or neutered pet is \$10.00 annually. If no certificate is produced verifying that your pet has been spayed or neutered, the fee will be amended to \$50.00 per year.

All pets found within the communities of Holland and Cypress River without a tag will be considered strays and will be dealt with according.



Also note that in accordance with By-Law No: 1329/2010, no person shall own, harbor, keep or have in their possession, control or premises more than three (3) dogs and three (3) cats, regardless of the number of people who may be reside at a specific residence.

As pet owners you are responsible for the feces that your cat or dog produces. Removal and sanitary disposal of feces from public and private property, other than your own is a requirement under By-Law No: 1329/2010.

Every person who commits an offence of a continuing nature against this By-Law is liable to a fine not exceeding \$100.00 for each day such offence continues.
